## Community Presentations

Kidsafe WA offers a range of presentations and workshops to new parent groups, child care centres, playgroups and other community groups.

### 12 Key Things to Keep Kids Safe

"12 Key Things to Keep Kids Safe" provides a practical overview of child safety and is an ideal presentation for groups who want to focus on more than one area of child safety.

The presentation covers issues that arise at home, on the road and at play. It provides practical steps to help parents and carers protect children from drowning, scalds, fire, poisoning, strangulation, crush injuries, animals, falls, and injuries that can occur as vehicle passengers or pedestrians.



### Home Safety Workshop

The Home Safety Workshop is a free education session that provides tips on how to keep children injury free.

With a focus on the risks to children under 5 years, the workshop examines potential dangers in each area of the home.

Learn how to improve child safety in the bathroom, kitchen, laundry, bedroom, living areas and backyard, to prevent poisoning, falls, burns, scalds, choking, suffocation and much more!

Kidsafe visits regional areas throughout the year to run Home Safety Workshops.



### Seasonal Safety

Kidsafe WA's Seasonal Safety Campaign focuses on four key injury risks to children throughout the year:

- Autumn: Falls
- Winter: Burns and Scalds
- Spring: Poisons
- Summer: Holiday Safety

Presentations and workshops are available free of charge (during the corresponding season) to community groups. The sessions can be tailored to meet specific needs of CaLD and Indigenous new parent groups.



### Naturally Kids Play

Do you remember climbing trees, making cubbies, rolling down grassy hills and digging in the sand? If you do, you have experienced natural play!

As part of our Playground Advisory Service, the "Naturally Kids Play" workshops discuss the benefits of natural playgrounds, how they relate to the Australian Standards and how natural and manufactured playspaces can be combined. Perfect for local councils, child care centres, community groups, schools and parents.

### Smart Steps

**Smart Steps** is a free parent and carer community based education program that supports parents and carers to model safe behaviours and make safer decisions in the road environment for young children 0-4 years. It addresses three key areas of risk; the use of child car restraints and general passenger safety, safe pedestrian practices and safer play. The workshops focus on the important role parents and carers play in teaching their children safer road user behaviours. It provides valuable information, as well as road safety activities that can be run with children.
