Planet ThinkSafe Quiz

Curriculum Framework Activity Outcomes

Phases of Development

Middle to late childhood (typically years 4 – 7)

Activity Resources Required

Option 1

- Information on the ThinkSafe SAM steps and Beat the Clock Quiz from *Planet ThinkSafe* at www.worksafe.wa.gov.au/planet or contact WorkSafe.
- Art materials such as crayons, pencils, scissors, glue, paper and cardboard.

Option 2

- Computers with access to Planet ThinkSafe, and in particular Beat the Clock Quiz.

Procedure

Option 1

1. Consider the questions in the Beat the Clock Quiz on Planet ThinkSafe website and use these or your own questions. Sort them into categories such as home, school, road and playgrounds.
2. Make quiz cards or a quiz sheet and place category signs on the blackboard/whiteboard.
3. Explain and discuss the ThinkSafe SAM steps and quiz activity with students.
4. Divide class into three or four teams and play the quiz.
5. Lead discussion with students on safety tips learnt from playing the quiz.

Option 2

1. Use computers in computer lab for students to complete Planet ThinkSafe activities and the Beat the Clock Quiz online.

- Invite parents and grandparents to assist with running the quiz and keeping the tally or oversee the online activity.
