Years 4-6:

Design a Comic Strip

Ask children to design a comic strip about safety. The comic strip can be up to 2 pages long and can be designed using paints, pencils, textas, crayons, or any other medium. Examples of safety messages include how to cross the road safely, gas safety and preventing burns.

6. The winning entries may be published in future school promotional materials that are distributed to all Primary Schools and District High Schools in Western Australia, on Kidsafe WA social media and on the Kidsafe WA website.
7. Entries will be judged on creativity and on the safety message they depict.
8. Judging will take place by Friday 11th October 2019 by representatives from Kidsafe WA, ATCO and other relevant agencies. Their decision will be final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Winners will be contacted by Friday 18th October 2019 using the school telephone or email details provided.
10. Names and schools of winners may be posted on the Kidsafe WA website and Kidsafe WA social media pages.
11. There will be first, second and third prizes awarded for each category (three prizes for years 1-3 and three prizes for years 4-6).
12. First prize will include a \$250 Coles & Myer voucher for the winning student's class and a \$50 Coles & Myer voucher and one ATCO Kids Cookbook for the winning student.
